REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Keystone RV Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2006 NRG Model 230FS with the manual pull down bunk bed. These units have an incorrectly fastened support ledge on bunk bed assemblies. An incorrectly fastened bunk can collapse and cause injury.

WHAT WE WILL DO

A notice has been sent to your selling dealership regarding this situation. The Dealers stand ready to assist you in addressing this condition by inspecting the vertical guide channels on the bunk bed of your recreational vehicle to determine if it is affected. If affected, the Dealer will properly re-install the bunk without charge.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

At your earliest convenience, please make an appointment to have your Travel Trailer serviced by your dealership. The recreational vehicle will need to be at the dealer to perform this service correction approximately one (1) day. Please ask your dealer if you wish to know how much additional time will be needed to schedule and process your travel trailer.

Your Keystone RV dealer is best equipped to obtain parts and provide service to ensure your travel trailer is corrected as promptly as possible. If your dealer is unable to assist, please contact Keystone Customer Service by calling 1-866-425-4369. If you take your Travel Trailer to your dealer on the agreed service date, and the Dealer does not remedy the condition within a reasonable amount of time, or without charge to you, please contact Keystone Customer Service by calling 1-866-425-4369.
